Using Telemet Orion’s Replication Feature

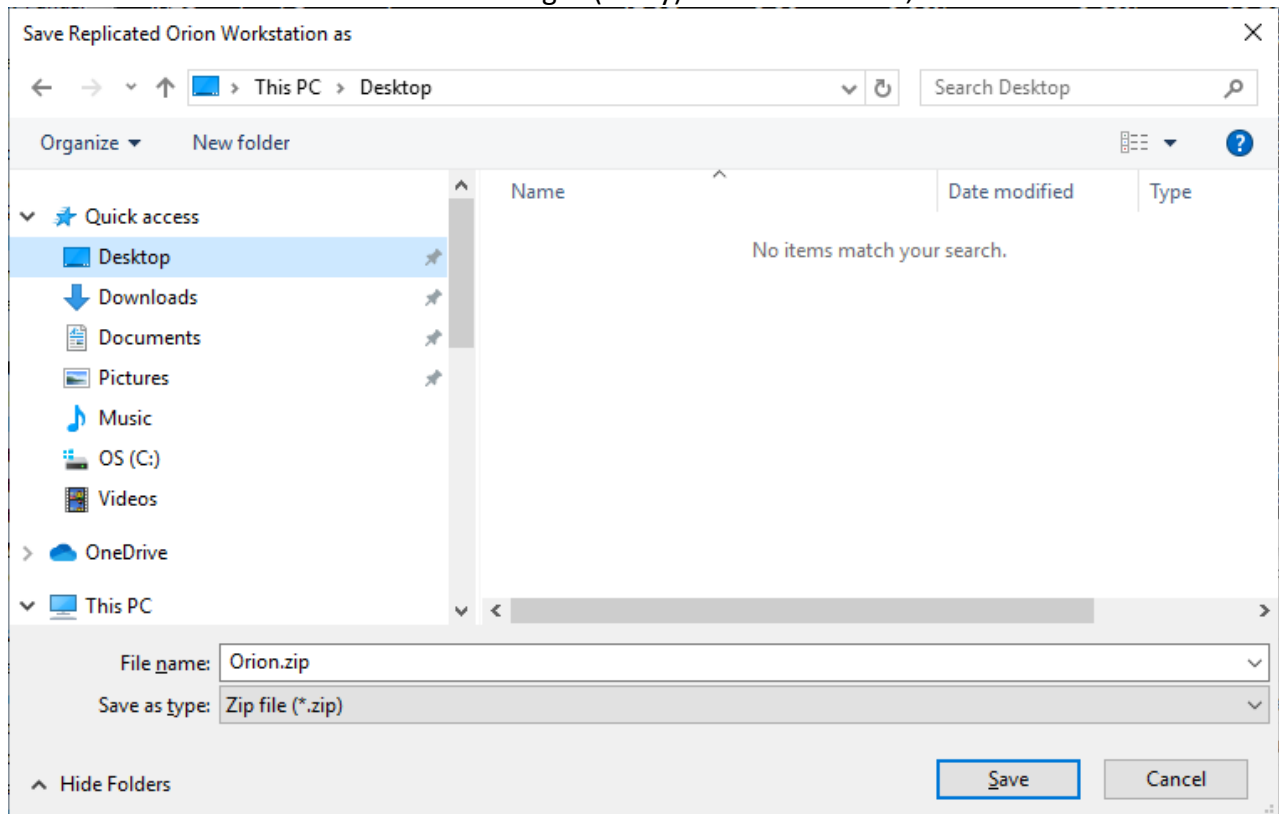
Telemet Orion’s Replication feature is a handy tool that is used to copy a user’s customized Orion files (Lists, Pages, Workspaces, etc) from one Orion workstation to another. The process creates a compressed (zip) file that contains all the user’s Orion customizations which can then be imported to another workstation or workstations where Orion is installed.

Common uses for this feature are to move customized Orion settings from an old computer to a new one, from an office workstation to a home PC or laptop, or to create a quick backup of a user’s customized Orion settings.

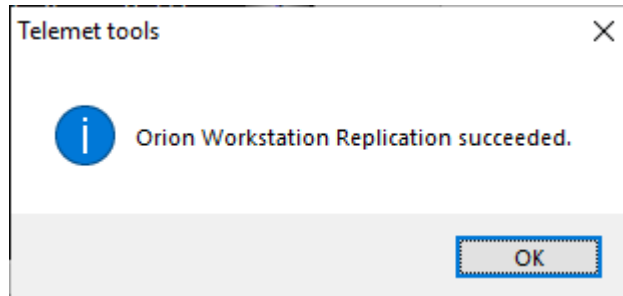
Please be aware that when importing an Orion Replication, any previously existing Orion customizations on the importing computer will be overwritten by the replicated files.

Creating an Orion Replication file:

- 1) Connect with Orion on the computer whose settings are to be Replicated.
- 2) Choose Tools, Replicate, with Registration. (*‘with Registration’* means that the Replication file will also copy the Orion passwords that the workstation is currently using. If the Replication is going to be imported by a different user, choose *‘without Registration’*.)
- 3) On the resulting dialog screen, type the Replication file’s name and choose the location where it will be saved. Once the changes (if any) have been made, choose Save.



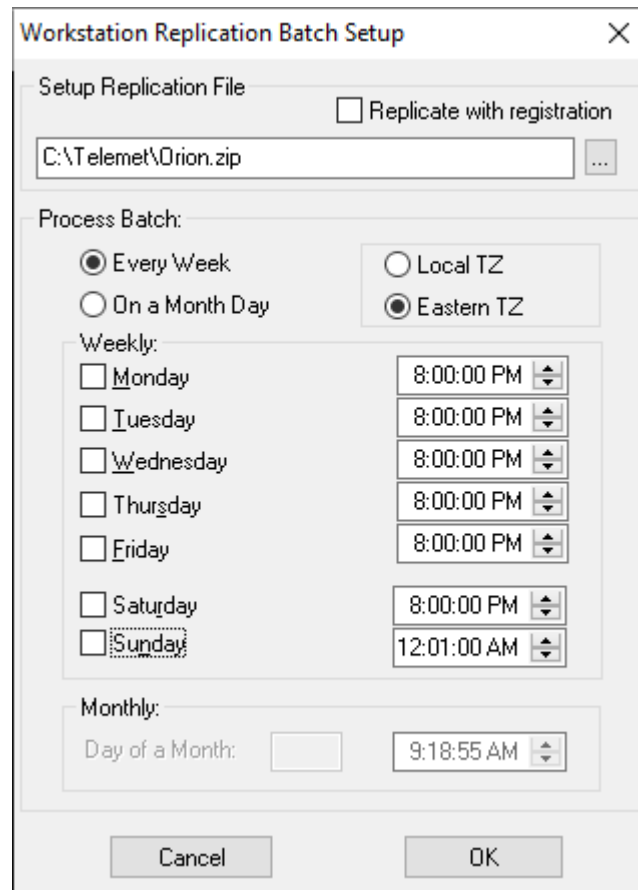
4) When the Save process is complete you will see the following message:



5) The resulting Replication file can be emailed to another Orion workstation, transferred via flash drive or copied to a shared network location.

Scheduling Replications (optional)

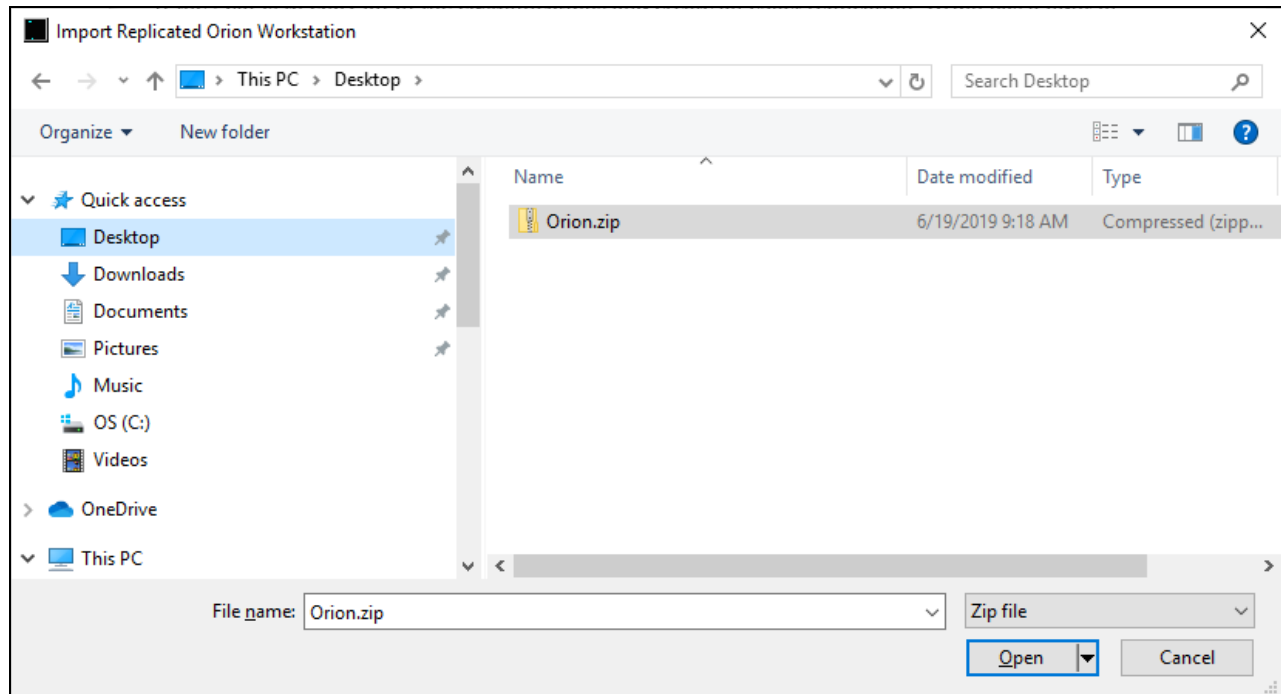
1) You can also optionally schedule regular Replications to keep your replication file current. Choose Tools, Replicate, Schedule, WS Replication Setup... to access the Workstation Replication Batch Setup screen.



- 2) Set the path to the location of your replications, and the frequency with which you wish to create a replication backup file.
- 3) Choose OK.

Importing an Orion Replication file:

- 1) Connect with Orion on the computer where the Replicated settings are to be imported
- 2) Choose Tools, Replicate, Import
- 3) Use the resulting dialog screen to browse to the location where the Replicated file was saved and select it

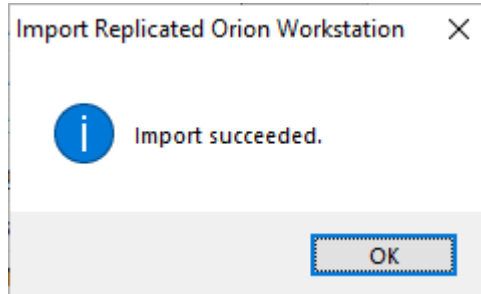


- 4) Click Open. Orion shut will down all windows, and import the settings from the selected Replication file. The result will be an exact duplication of the customized settings from the original Orion workstation.

5) Click on OK when the following message appears:



6) Telemet Orion will restart with the settings imported from the replication file.

Helpful Tip: Since your Replication file is a good backup of your current Telemet Orion settings it is recommended that you save a copy to a network drive or another location that can be accessed separately from your computer.
